



# Pass Burn V2A2II



## Location

Greenstone valley, Glenorchy, Otago, New Zealand.

## Character

Easy canyon with walking sections, a few abseils and some jumps

## Approach by car

Drive from Queenstown to Glenorchy, go to Kinloch and follow the dirt road to the Greenstone carpark. You will have to pass some fords.

## Approach to the hut

Follow the Greenstone Track to the Greenstone hut. (3 hours)

## Approach to canyon

Starting at Greenstone Hut, follow the Mavora Walkway for approximately 2 kilometres to the creek crossing (645 m), which marks the start of the canyon.

## Water

No hazards with low / normal flow.

## Catchment

10 km<sup>2</sup>

## Map

CC09

## Anchors

Single bolts - Tebylon ring 10mm 316L

## Gear

Minimum of 1x30 meter rope and a saftyline

## Route description

Start with a 300 m walk in the creek, where you'll see beautiful green and red rocks. An easy abseil follows, combined with a short downclimb, bringing you to the first 6 m jump. Always check the pools, as they can be shallow. Another downclimb leads to a 3 m jump. The next abseil currently has no fixed points; we rigged it from a rock TL. After another walking section, you reach a beautiful 12 m waterfall with a great swimming spot. A potential jump is possible on the TL.

## Time

Car park to hut: 3h (12km)

Hut to canyon start: 30min

Time in the canyon: 1h 30min

Exit back to hut: 30min

Hut to car park: 3h


Total time one day: 8h 30min


